

EMJMD – Main Aims

- Quality, innovation, excellence and internationalisation in HEIs
- Quality and attractiveness of EHEA
- Competences, skills and employability of Master graduates
- Relevance for the labour market
- "Jointness" high level of course integration

EMJMD – Consortium


- At least 3 HEIs from 3 different Programme Countries:
 EU & FL, IS, MK, NO, RS, TR
- Additional partners from Programme/Partner Countries:
 - HEI
 - Public or private enterprise/business (small, medium, large)
 - Public body at local, regional or national level
 - Non-profit organisation, association, NGO
 - Research institute

EMJMD – Curriculum

- Highly integrated Master delivered by international HEI consortium
- No restriction in disciplines
- Duration: 12/18/24 months (60/90/120 ECTS)
- 4 consecutive student intakes optional: preparatory year
- Mandatory study period in at least 2 different Programme Countries
 optional: studies in Partner Countries (15 ECTS) or internships
- Award of a joint, double or multiple Master degree
- Full scholarships for students
- Accreditation/recognition at application stage! NEW: European Approach for Quality Assurance of Joint Projects (Yerevan 2015)

EMJMD – Students

- Excellent graduates at least first HE level or equivalent level
- From Programme and Partner Countries (at least 75%)
- Full time scholarships insurance included
- From the very beginning: students get full support from the consortium, issues like visa and housing
- During the stay: tutor and buddy systems
- Student Agreement with rights and obligations
- Students already during their studies members of EMA

EMJMD - Funding

- up to 4,5 million Euro/EMJMD
- 20 000 Euro for preparatory year (optional) + 50 000 Euro/intake

Contribution to (Euro)	Partner Countries	Programme Countries
Participation costs (citizenship*)	up to 9 000/year	up to 4 500/year
Travel costs (actual residence)	2 000 year (< 4 000 km) 3 000/year (> 4 000 km)	1 000/year
Installation costs (actual residence)	1 000	
Subsistence costs*	1 000/month	1 000/month



EMJMD - Draft Call 2019

- 138 million Euro (Heading 1) & 38-40 million Euro (Heading 4)
- **Around 45 EMJMD:**
 - Up to 4,5 million Euro each duration: 4-6 years
 - 60 student scholarships in total at least 75% from Partner Countries

Region 8: Latin America*

- Optional (H4): up to 28 additional student scholarships in total
 - Region 1: Western Balkans
 - Region 2: Eastern Partnership
 - Region 3: South-Mediterranean
 - Region 6: Asia*
 - Region 7: Central Asia*
- 4 scholars/intake
