## **Jean Monnet activities**

- aim at promoting excellence in teaching and research in the field of European Union studies worldwide
- aim at fostering the dialogue between the academic world and the society
- generate knowledge and insights that can support EU policy-making and strengthen the role of the EU in a globalised world

# **Teaching and Research**

3 year duration	MODULE	Min 40 teaching hours/year max grant: 30 000 €	
	CHAIR	Chair Holder: Min 90 teaching hours/year + at least 1 additional activity, <b>max grant</b> : 50 000 €	
	*CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE	Focal points of competence and knowledge <b>max grant</b> : 100 000 €	

#### Aims:

- foster the introduction of a European Union angle into mainly non EU related studies
- teaching on EU matters in curricula which so far have included EU-related content only to a limited extent

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#### **Activities**:

- general or introductory courses on European Union issues (including summer schools)
- provide teaching/lectures to students from other departments
- leading research activities in specific European Union subjects

## **Teaching and Research**

one particular discipline in EU studies EU studies embodied in an official curriculum of HEIs synergies between the various disciplines and resources in EU studies

### **Support to Associations**

	should be <b>interdisciplinary</b> and open to all interested professors, teachers and researchers specialising in EU issues
ASSOCIATION	should be <b>representative of the academic community</b> in EU studies at regional, national or supranational level 3-year grants, <b>max grant:</b> 50 000 €

### Aims:

 become reference points in the European Union subject areas they cover

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**Activities**:

- organise and carry out statutory activities of associations dealing with EU studies and EU issues
- perform research in the field of specific EU issues in order to advise European policy makers and disseminate the outcomes among the institutions involved in these issues

### **Policy debate**

NETWORK	International consortia players in area of EU studies (HEIs, Centres of Excellence, departments, etc.) min 3 partner institutions from 3 different countries, 3- year grants, <b>max grant:</b> 300 000 €	
*PROJECT	innovation, cross-fertilisation, spread of EU content, involvement of other partners possible, duration 12 – 24 months, <b>max grant</b> : 60 000 €	

### Aims:

- build knowledge and promote the European integration process across the world
- boost EU knowledge in specific contexts



### **Activities**:

- exchanging knowledge and expertise with a view to mutually enhancing good practices
- organise conferences, seminars and/or roundtables in relevant EU issues for the broadest possible array of stakeholders
